There is a high school team division and a collegiate team division. Max of 24 teams per division.

4 Person team scratch event. Event is broken out into two parts, the first part, bowlers are competing for points to be added their team's total for seeding purposes and the second part is team baker double elimination bracket match play.

Entry Fee: \$300 per team or \$75 per bowler (\$20 Lineage, \$45 Prize Fund, \$5 Awards, \$5 Expenses)

Teams: Each team will consist of 2 male bowlers and 2 female bowlers. Each team is allowed one coach who must be RVP approved.

Event: Event is broken out into 2 parts. The first part consists of 6 rounds where bowlers will earn points for their teams. The six rounds are:

Round 1 & 2 – Singles (bowlers from each team will compete against a bowler from three other teams in a one game match)

Round 3 – Doubles (doubles teams will compete against three doubles teams in a one game match)

Round 4 & 5 – Mixed Doubles (Similar to doubles round)

Round 6 – Team baker event (each team will bowl 4 baker games on 4 lanes with 1 game per lane against three other teams, points awarded based on the 4 game total for those 4 lanes) Baker game will have 1st bowler bowl frames 1, 5, and 9. Second bowler frames 2, 6, and 10. Third bowler frames 3 and 7. Fourth bowler frames 4 and 8. Teams can change their line-ups after each game.

Teams will be seeded based on total points into the match play bracket round. Pinfall will break any ties in the point standings. The top 8 teams will be seeded into the Gold bracket, those seeded 9th – 16th will be in the silver bracket, and those seeded 17th – 24th will be in the bronze bracket.

Round 7 & beyond – Best 2 out of 3 double elimination bracket match play. Higher seed getting starting lane choice. Each game is a baker game on the same lane.

Points: For rounds 1 through 6 bowlers can earn points. In each round the highest score or total will win 4 points per bowler, 2nd highest will receive 3 points per bowler, 3rd highest will receive 2 points per bowler and lowest will receive 1 point per bowler based on 4 teams competing against each other. For singles highest will get 4 and lowest will get 1. For doubles and mixed doubles highest team will get 8 and lowest will get 4 each bowler getting half of total points awarded. For team baker highest team will get 16 points and lowest will get 4 points each bowler would get anywhere from 1 to 4 points.

Practice: Bowlers will receive 15 minutes of practice before round 1 and no practice will be provided for rounds 2-6. Teams will get 3 practice balls on each lane before each match in bracket play.

All Tournament Team: Bowlers can earn a spot on the All Tournament team after round 6. All Tournament team will consist of the top three bowlers based on total points (pinfall breaks ties) and the top three remaining bowlers based on total pinfall.

Scholarships 1 out of every 4 teams will win scholarship money. At least 1 team per bracket will win scholarship money. If we have 24 teams then at least 3 teams in the gold bracket, 2 teams in the silver bracket and 1 team in the bronze bracket will win scholarship money. Bowlers on the All Tournament Team could win scholarships depending on the number of teams competing. If less than 16 teams then the top point earner and the bowler with the highest pinfall will get scholarships. Bowlers will not win scholarships both in points and pinfall. If we have 24 teams then all the bowlers on the all tournament team will win scholarships. Scholarships will be submitted into the bowler's SMART account.

Dress Code: Teams are highly encouraged to wear matching jerseys if not available then same color jerseys. Men are encouraged to wear slacks. Women are encouraged to wear slacks, skirts, or skorts of appropriate length. No denim or shorts please.

Divisions: A max of 24 teams per division. Divisions are high school teams and collegiate teams. Co-op teams are allowed. Only up to 2 schools can be represented on a team just as long as two bowlers represent each school unless approved by tournament director.

Event is a scratch event. No handicap will be given to the bowlers.
